The PPBSO makes every effort to ensure competitors are judged as objectively as possible. In assigning available judges, potential conflicts of interest are taken into account and wherever possible avoided. It is recognized that this is not always possible due to the size of our judging group and highly socialized nature of piping and drumming activity. Complete objectivity is the aspiration in assigning judges but note that contests will not be canceled due to the limited availability of judges brought on by stated conflicts of interest.

Special Notes

- It is the responsibility of the competitor to be fully aware of all Rules & Regulations
- **Solo entries must be received at least 3 weeks prior to the contest date.**
- A competitor under 19 years of age on June 1st may compete as a youth for that calendar year.
- Field entries will not be accepted.
- Full payment must accompany each entry.
- Events may be withdrawn at the discretion of the PPBSO Board of Directors.
- Contests are scheduled to begin at 8:30 a.m. sharp.
- Competitors must report to the Steward for each contest no later than the commencement of the contest. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- Refunds will only be given if event is cancelled.
