- Full payment must accompany each entry
- PPBSO Bands \$56.50 entry.
- Non PPBSO bands add \$10.50 to each entry (\$67.00)
- A \$25.00 service fee **will** be charged on all NSF cheques and credit card payments that are not approved.
- Band entries must be received at least **3 weeks prior** to the contest date **except for Maxville, entries must be received by June 17, 2024.**
- Events may be withdrawn at the discretion of the PPBSO Board of Directors.
- Kincardine Scottish Festival limited to 25 bands (priority given to Grade 1 and 2 bands).
- Embro Highland Games limited to 12 band entries.
- Each pipe band **must** submit a roster of members with entry form. Juvenile bands must include Date of Birth on their roster.
- Each pipe band **must send an adult playing member** as a representative to the band meeting on the day of the games. Meeting usually takes place at 11am (subject to change).
- Each pipe band **must** provide someone to coordinate their prompt arrival on the contest field.
- All Bands are required to move through the final tuning area.
- The criteria for a band qualifying for travel money varies from contest to contest; please contact the PPBSO for details.

- For Grade 1 at Maxville, the set will be drawn at the 11:00 meeting.

- The duty band will be drawn from all participating Grade 1 and 2 bands in rotation.
- Information on prize money, travel money and travel directions are available upon request from the PPBSO.
- It is the responsibility of the competing band to be aware of all rules & regulations. Information on this form is not necessarily complete. Refer to PPBSO Rule Book or PPBSO website for specific information (<https://www.pipbandsontario.org/ppbso-rule-book>), including Massed Band tunes. Bands authorize the Pipers' and Pipe Band Society of Ontario to broadcast, make video and audio recordings of competition performances. Such recordings from the North American Championships may be sold to the general public without payment of royalties to bands or individuals. Recordings from other contests may be freely distributed to other competing bands. As a condition of acceptance of this entry band members individually waive and relieve all claims.

Grade 2	2 Sets (2/4 march, strathspey and reel) 1 Medley - 4 to 7 minutes	6 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers. Gr. 2 bands may add a higher grade piper as their Pipe Major only, in addition to the minimum of 6 other pipers, provided he/she is registered as their piping instructor. Gr. 2 bands may add a higher grade drummer, in addition to the minimum of 2 other snare drummers, provided he/she is registered as their drumming instructor. Grade 2 pipe bands may add a higher grade tenor drummer, providing that he or she is registered as their tenor drumming instructor. The band must also field at least one other tenor drummer
Grade 3	1 Set (2/4 march, strathspey and reel) 1 Medley - 3 to 6 minutes	5 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers. Gr.3 bands may add a higher grade piper as their Pipe Major only, in addition to the minimum of 5 other pipers provided he/she is registered as their piping instructor. Gr. 3 bands may add a higher grade drummer, in addition to the minimum of 2 other snare drummers, provided he/she is registered as their drumming instructor. Grade 3 pipe bands may add a higher-grade tenor drummer, providing the player is registered as their tenor drumming instructor. The band must also field at least one other tenor drummer
Grade 4	1 Medley - 3 to 5 minutes 1 March Medley in Quick-time - 2:45 to 4:30 minutes	5 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers. Gr.4 bands may add a higher grade piper as their Pipe Major or Pipe Sergeant only, in addition to the minimum of 5 pipers provided he/she is registered as their piping instructor. Gr. 4 bands may add a higher grade drummer, in addition to the minimum of 2 snare drummers provided he/she is registered as their drumming instructor. Grade 4 pipe bands may add a higher grade tenor drummer as their lead tenor drummer only, providing the player is registered as their tenor drumming instructor. The band must also field at least one other tenor drummer
Grade 5	1 March Medley in Quick-time - 2:45 to 4:30 minutes	5 pipers, 1 bass, 2 snare drummers. Gr.5 bands may add a higher grade piper as their Pipe Major or Pipe Sergeant only, in addition to the minimum of 5 pipers provided he/she is registered as their piping instructor. Gr. 5 bands may add a higher grade drummer, in addition to the minimum of 2 snare drummers provided he/she is registered as their drumming instructor. Grade 5 pipe bands may add a higher grade tenor drummer, providing the player is registered as their tenor drumming instructor. The band must also field at least one other tenor drummer
Juvenile	1 March Medley in Quick-time - 2:45 to 4:30 minutes	5 pipers, 2 snare drummers, 1 bass, all of eligible juvenile age. Juvenile bands may add a non-juvenile piper as Pipe Major in addition to the minimum 5 juvenile age pipers. Juvenile bands may add a non-juvenile drummer as their lead drummer in addition to the minimum 2 juvenile age snare drummers
